
Fun for Junior Members




Regions: The Society is organised into six regions to ensure activities are arranged close to where you live: Scotland, Northern, Midlands (including Wales), Eastern, Southern and South West. In addition, we have several overseas groups.





Publications: As a member you will receive several highquality publications. *Signals*, produced three times a year, outlines the Society's news and gives details of each region's activities, *Mixed Moss* is our annual literary journal devoted to longer articles, whilst **The Outlaw** is specifically produced for junior members.







Events: Each year an International AGM family weekend is held where activities and speakers are organized with choice for all. In alternative years we hold a Literary Weekend with speakers on a variety of Ransome-related topics.

Library: TARS is fortunate in having a well-stocked library. Members may borrow the books that Ransome read, along with others of interest, including all the Carnegie medal winners for the outstanding children's book of the year.

Society stall: this holds numerous books, CDs, merchandise, clothing and Ransome related material for you to buy.
